

MARQUETTE TOWNSHIP PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WATER CONNECTION PERMIT PROCEDURE

In order to connect to the Marquette Township public water system you must obtain the following permits:

1. County Road Commission Right of Way Permit.
2. County Plumbing Permit.
3. Township Connection Permit.

To obtain your road right-of-way permit, contact your contractor or call the Marquette County Road Commission (486-4491).

To obtain the plumbing permit, contact your contractor or call the Marquette County Resource Management, Construction Codes (225-8180).

You must obtain the plumbing and R.O.W. permits before you can obtain a connection permit from the Township. Please have copies of these permits available when you apply for the Township connection permit.

To obtain your connection permit, please come to the Township office during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

In addition, to obtain the connection permit you will need to pay the water connection permit fee of \$3,000 for a single family residence. Also, you will have to pay a \$40.00 deposit.

The developer is responsible for all excavation and restoration, both within the right-of-way, and on private property. The Township will install the tap and piping to the property line if necessary.

For temporary water service during construction, a hydrant meter can be rented for a \$45.00 monthly fee plus water per gallon fee.
