

## MARQUETTE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

Did You Know . . .

- That on May 5 your Township Board of Trustees will decide whether or not to complete construction of our own Township water supply?
- That the Township has been awarded economic stimulus funds to pay for 40% (up to \$2.12 million) of the total cost?
- That the Township has been approved for Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Drinking Water Revolving Loan funding for the project at 2.5% over twenty years?
- That the total residential water customer cost of the debt retirement over the twenty year period is estimated to be \$8.00/month - less that \$2,000 total?
- That only water customers connected to the Township water system will pay the debt retirement?
- That a petition signed by 628 Township voters has been filed in opposition to the Township Board's proposed bonding to fund this project?
- That there are over 2,200 Township voters that did not sign the petition, and have not made their position on the project or the proposed bonding known to the Township Board?
- That governing Boards generally respond to what they hear from their constituents?
- That if you do not voice your position, it may not be considered?

All Township residents are asked to tell your Township Board what you want regarding this critically important question that will affect the future water supply for your township. The May 5 Township Board meeting starts at 7:00pm at the Marquette Township Hall. Remember, decisions are influenced by those that participate.
